

Practical information

1. Your Admission

If you require hospitalization, in one of our CHIREC sites, the administrative procedures related to registration must be completed at the admission office.

For your registration, we ask that you bring with you:

- Your identity card or passport,
- your SIS card,
- x-rays or CD's and protocols of previous examinations,
- possibly the doctor's request requiring hospitalization,
- contact of the doctor.

IF YOU ENTER IN EMERGENCY:

Formalities are carried out wherever possible by a family member with the admission.

4. Your stay at the hospital

WHAT DO YOU HAVE TO TAKE WITH YOU?

- Night clothes,
- slippers,
- towels and toilet necessary,
- list of medicines and dietary requirements.

YOUR ROOM:

After the admission procedure, you will be guided to your room.

A nurse will help you to get settled. She will also explain the equipment, which has been designed to ensure your well-being and safety.

SAFETY:

The hospital is an open space. It is difficult to control all comings and goings. It is highly recommended not to take valuables. Failing that, deposit them in the safe in your room or at the admission (this service is not available in the Basilique Clinic and is not available in the D building of the Braine-l'Alleud-Waterloo Hospital).

For a communication to the outside:

(for the Edith Cavell, Basilique, Braine-l'Alleud sites):

*42 + your 4 digit code + 0 followed by your correspondant's number.

for the Parc Leopold site:

*41 + your 4 digit code + 0 followed by your correspondant's number.

for the Sainte-Anne Saint-Remi site:

you must have a code given by the admission service.

Dial the 8 figure code + o followed by the phone number.

TELEVISION:

Each room has a colour television. The hospital has cable television; we can therefore, offer our guests at least ten channels. For the Basilique Clinic and Sainte-Anne Saint-Remi Clinic, you have to pay a caution for the television remote and you have to pay television.

INTERNET:

If you wish to have access to Internet, inquire upon admission about the administrative procedures. This service is available at the Edith Cavell, Parc Leopold, Basilique and Braine-l'Alleud site.







MEALS:

Weekly menus are proposed. They offer a wide range of dishes for the main meals. The staff will take care to note the patient's choices in due time.

Don't hesitate to ask the nurses to call the dietetician for any alimentary question.

In some of our clinics, you will have the possibility to taste quality products in our "Tasty".

HAIRDRESSER - PEDICURE - ESTHETICIAN :

On some of our sites (Cavell, Parc Leopold, St-Anne St-Remi and Braine-l'Alleud-Waterloo), these services are available.

If you wish to receive it, please follow these steps:

- Basilique Clinic : check with the nurse.
- Edith Cavell Clinic: beautician: 0472/83 16 10
- Parc Leopold Clinic: check with the nurse.
- Sainte-Anne Saint-Remi Clinic: check with the nurse (hairdressing service available Monday and Friday, pedicure service available Thursday and Friday).
- Braine-l'Alleud-Waterloo Hospital: check with the nurse.

RELIGIOUS OR MORAL SUPPORT:

The hospital Group respects all convictions, whether personal, religious, moral, or philosophical. Upon admission, you may fill in the appropriate form and call upon a lay counselor or a representative of the religion of your choice.

OTHER:

Cut flowers are permitted, but plants are probited because of hygiene.

The hospital is tobacco-free and anyway, the law formally prohibits smoking in the hospital.









5. Your departure

The day and the hour of your departure will be decided by your doctor.

For the sites Edith Cavell, the patient informs his departure of the checkout. For the site of Braine-l'Alleud-Waterloo, the patient informs his departure of the admission or the reception.

You will receive by mail the total bill for your hospitalization, resuming the subsistence of any examination performing during your stay, pharmacy, specific material, sundry expenses and fees, which are deducted from the refunds of your deposits and mutual.



We hope that you will be satisfied with the quality of our care and services you have received. We would, however, be happy to know the degree of your satisfaction, so that we may improve. 
